Proposed Regulatory Revisions January 21, 2009

- 1. Amend Section 16.3 (Exceptions to Prohibition Without Permit) by removing the last paragraph (16.3.C) regarding the allowing of law enforcement agencies to open burn contraband. The paragraph to be removed currently reads as follows:
 - "C. Fires set at the direction of law enforcement agencies or courts for the purpose of destruction of controlled substances and legal drugs seized as contraband. Priming materials used to facilitate such burning shall be limited to #1 and #2 grade fuel oils."
- 2. Add the following sentence to the end of Section 25.8.I.4 and Section 25.8.I.7.(b) regarding a set minimum fee for major sources:
 - "Notwithstanding any calculation of an annual fee using these rates, the annual fee that each major source is to pay shall not be less than \$7,500 for the annual accounting period."
- 3. Amend Section 35.2.2 by adding the following entry which reads as listed below:
- "YYYYYY. National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Area Sources: Ferroalloys Production Facilities, as specified in 40 CFR 63, SubpartYYYYYY, as amended, as adopted by Knox County on January 21, 2009."
