Consideration of an Ordinance of the Commission of Knox County, Tennessee repealing Ordinance No.O-08-4-101 and Ordinance No.O-0-8-4-102 and amending Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Knox County Charter to modify the Charter Review Committee process and to change the timeframe required for a proposed charter amendment to be placed on the ballot (Knox County Charter as adopted 11-8-88, as amended through Referendum of 8-6-04) Ordinance of the Commission of Knox County, Tennessee repealing Ordinance No.O-08-4-101 and Ordinance No.O-08-4-102 and amending Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Knox County Charter to modify the Charter Review Committee process and to change the timeframe required for a proposed charter amendment to be placed on the ballot (Knox County Charter as adopted 11-8-88, as amended through

Referendum of 8-6-04) was before the Board of Commissioners on first reading.

Commissioners Leuthold and Lambert voted no. Commissioners McKenzie, Norman, Moore and Wright were absent from the meeting. The motion carried 13-2-0-4.

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Upon roll call vote of the substitute motion rescind O-08-4-101 - Ordinance of the Commission of Knox County, Tennessee amending Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Knox County Charter to modify the Charter Review Committee Process (Knox County Charter as adopted 11-8-88, as amended through referendum of 8-6-04) and to rescind O-08-4-102 – Ordinance of the Commission of Knox County, Tennessee, amending Article IX, Section 9.05 of the Knox County Charter to change the time frame required for a proposed charter amendment to be placed on the ballot (Knox County Charter as adopted 11-8-88, as amended through Referendum of 8-6-04) Commissioners Strickland, Mark Harmon, Campen, Ivan Harmon, Davis,
