County Budget Presentation, Public Meetings Planned

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.—Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs will present his Fiscal Year 2020 budget proposal to the Knox County Commission at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, May 1. The presentation will take place in the Central High School Auditorium (5321 Jacksboro Pike). Those unable to attend the presentation will be able to view it live on CTV Channel 12 or on both the Mayor's and the Knox County Government Facebook pages later in the day.

Mayor Jacobs will be available to meet with media immediately following the address.
