Increase in Waste over Averages:

Bagged Household Trash: 28% increase (from 2832 tons to 3628 tons)
 Bulky Waste: 55% increase (from 1175 tons to 1823 tons)
 Scrap Metal: 101% increase (from 241 tons to 485 tons)
 Cardboard: 19% increase (from 146 tons to 173 tons)
 All Recycling 40% increase (from 651 tons to 914 tons)
 All Waste/Recycling: 37% increase (from 4658 tons to 6365 tons)
