Mayor Jacobs to Speak About Juneteenth, TCAT Scholarship and Reopening Guidelines

Knoxville, Tennessee—During his Weekly Update, which will post at about 3 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs will issue a proclamation recognizing Juneteenth in Knox County.

The Mayor will also speak about his experiences attending high school graduations, the DOE grant issued to the University of Tennessee for the Oak Ridge Institute, the new TCAT Knoxville Scholarship and preparations for Beaver Creek Flotilla.

He will also offer thoughts about the Board of Health's recommendation to begin following the State's reopening guidelines in two weeks.
