## **Mayor Jacobs Talks About Non-Profits, Schools, and Other Big Events**

*KNOXVILLE, Tenn.*—During his Weekly Update, which will post about 3 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs talks about the opening of the new East Tennessee Behavioral Health Hospital, a partnership between Covenant Health and Acadia Healthcare; providing welcoming remarks at Knox County School’s New Teacher Academy for Middle and High School Teachers; and speaking at Catholic Charities of East Tennessee as they announced the addition of Domestic Infant Adoption Services to their Pregnancy Help Programs.

He also asked folks to join him in person and author Sam Quinones via Zoom to discuss his latest book on the devastating drug epidemic, *The Least of Us*. The event takes place at the East Tennessee History Center at noon on Aug. 17, sponsored by Metro Drug Coalition, All4Knox, and Read City USA. Copies of the book are available at the library.
