Saturday's Concert Series Features Rockinfellerz and Crawdaddy Jones

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— The Second Saturday Concert Series wraps up this Saturday with Rockinfellerz playing at the Cove and Crawdaddy Jones taking the stage at Clayton Park.

The free concerts are held from 6 to 8 p.m. June through August on the second Saturday of each month. Attendees are encouraged to bring their own blankets, lawn chairs, and food. However, no alcohol is allowed.
