Mayor Jacobs Talks About Parks and Rec, the Land Use Plan, and More

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— During his Weekly Update, which will post around 3 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs talks about a county partnership with the Memphis Grizzlies, the “e-warning” notification system, and a draft of the Comprehensive Land Use and Transportation Plan.

Mayor Jacobs also notes that the Knox County Health Department is seeking individuals who have been impacted by dementia, either themselves or a loved one, to participate in a small group discussion so they can learn more about how to better support the patient and the caregiver before, during, and after diagnosis.
